According to NHDES' 2018 Arsenic MCL Report an estimated 120 (10%) of the state's non-transient public water systems will require improvements in blending or treatment in order to meet the new 5 ppb MCL, to be enforced starting Q3 2021. This seminar will review the new rule monitoring requirements and common blending and treatment solutions to reduce arsenic exposure to your customers and avoid system violations. We will discuss iron-arsenic filtration, adsorption media options, and Point of Use solutions for NTNC systems and very small community systems.
