## **Agenda:**

Lead is not a contaminant that typically gets into our water from the source. It is usually introduced from the plumbing through corrosion. But corrosion is a lot more than just a low pH. Water can be corrosive even without a low pH. This seminar will review the lead rules, what effects corrosion besides pH, what it means for a system “to be optimized”, what is compliance under the rules, what the typical corrosion control technologies are, when you might choose not to treat the corrosion and instead remove the lead from the water, and the application issues in the field for sizing, installing, and maintaining these systems.
