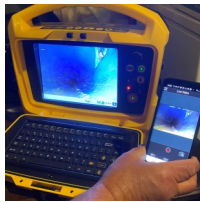
Drinking Water System Assistance

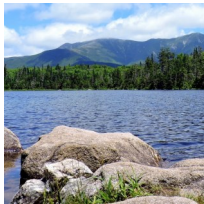
Wastewater System Assistance
